The Government of the Republic of Namibia has received financing from the African Development Bank hereinafter called the Bank toward the cost of the Namibia Water Sector Support Programme (NWSSP) and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for the Rehabilitation, Drilling and Test Pumping of Boreholes in the Otjombinde Constituency. For this contract, the Namibia Water Corporation Ltd. shall process the payments using the Direct Payment disbursement method, as defined in the Bank's Disbursement Guidelines and procedures for Investment Project Financing.

2. The Namibia Water Corporation Ltd. now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for the Rehabilitation, Drilling and Test Pumping of Boreholes in the northern and southern margin of the Eiseb Graben in the Otjombinde Constituency. The contract period is approximately 3 months and the general scope of works includes the following:

- Rehabilitation of 1 borehole,
- Drilling of 7 boreholes applying mud-rotary drilling method (250 m – 300 m deep),
- Test pumping of 8 boreholes.

3. Bidding will be conducted through the Open Competitive Bidding (National), OCBN procedures as specified in the Bank's [Procurement Framework](#) and is open to all eligible Bidders as defined in the Procurement Framework.

The bidding document in English may be purchased by interested eligible Bidders upon the submission of a written application to the address below and upon payment of a nonrefundable fee of Five hundred Namibian Dollars (NAD 500). The method of payment will be Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT). The document will be sent by electronic transfer, or bidders may obtain a hard copy at the Namibia Water Corporation Limited offices, depending on the bidder's preferred method of receipt.

6. Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before 11 August 2026 at 11h00 local Namibian time. Electronic Bidding will not be permitted. Late Bids will be rejected. Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the Bidders' designated representatives and anyone who chooses to attend at the address below on 11 August 2026 at 11h15 local Namibian time.

7. All Bids must be accompanied by a **Bid Security of One hundred and seventeen thousand Namibian Dollars (NAD 117,000)**.
